1. AKASHA The omnipresent fifth occult element which embraces the other four- earth, air, fire, and water.
2. ARADIA Italian goddess sworn to protect her people against aggression of masculine faith and its persecutors.
3. ASPECTING Any advanced magickal activity in which a practitioner manifests a particular aspect of the Goddess or God, in thought, feelings, behavior, appearance, etc.
4. ASPECTS Forms, facets, or personas of deity
5. ATHAME Black handled, double edged dagger.
6. COVEN A group of witches who worship and work together.
7. CANDLEMAS Festival held on feb. 1. One of the 4 Celtic "fire festivals.
8. CIRCLE The sacred space where in all magick is to be worked and all ritual contained.
9. COVENSTEAD Regular meeting place for a coven. Usually the home of the high priestess or high priest.
10. BELTANE May eve festival. One of the ancient Celtic "fire festivals."
11. COWAN Used in Wicca & witchcraft to mean a non-Wiccan/witch.
12. CHALICE A feminine symbol of the element water.
13. DEOSIL Clockwise movement for rituals and ceremonies and spells.
14. ELEMENTS Earth, air, fire, and water, plus spirit, which includes them all.
15. ESBAT Weekly or biweekly meeting of a coven. Traditionally held either on the full moon or the new moon.
16. FAMILIAR A spirit or guardian who is close to a human being and considered a companion in magick.
17. DIVINATION Using magickal tools and symbols to gather information from the collective unconscious.
18. GNOMES Elementals that dwell in the earth plane.
19. HALLOWS Name used by some traditions for Samhain, or Halloween
20. LAMMAS August 1st. Witch festival-the old Celtic name for this festival is Lughnassadh.
21. MAIDEN 1-Virgin; 2-an appointment held by one of the women of the coven.
22. PENTACLE A pentagram surrounded by a circle and carved on a circlet of wood or other natural object.
23. HANDFASTING Wiccan equivalent of a wedding. It can be made legal or may be binding within the coven.
24. PENTAGRAM A five-pointed star drawn with a single line.
25. PAGANING Presentation of an infant to the circle and to the gods.
26. REDE A tenet, rule, doctrine, or law.
27. SABBAT One of the eight celebrations of paganism.
28. IMBOLC Celtic name for Candlemas.
29. QUARTERS The north, east, south, and west parts of the circle, often representative of the four watchtowers.
30. SYLPH 1-Slender graceful woman; 2-an "entity" or "elemental" that dwells in the plane of air.
31. UNDINE An "entity" or "elemental" that dwells in the plane of water or is associated with the water element.
